Material of the Mazheik Jewish Community Council in the YIVO Archives

INTRODUCTION

Invaluable material, pertaining to the Jewish communities in Lithuania between the World Wars in general, and to the Mazheik (Mazeikiai in Lithuanian, מאַזייק in Yiddish) Jewish Community Council in particular, was rescued from destruction and looting by the Nazis and finally found its home in the Archives of the YIVO Institution for Jewish Research in New York City.

Until recently this material was not available for online review, requiring either physical access to the YIVO archives in New York or ordering and receiving hard copies of requested material.

During the years, partial research was done on the history of the Jewish community of Mazheik based on representative samples of the material.
